How to Record Slides Within PowerPoint of Keynote

PowerPoint on Windows 10:

- 1. Click on the **Slide Show** tab
- 2. Click on **Record Slide Show** button
- 3. On the lower right corner turn **OFF** camera and ensure that the microphone is turned **ON**
- 4. When ready to record, click the red **Record** button in the upper left
- 5. Begin talking through your presentation and be careful when transitioning between slides
- 6. Once finished, click the square **Stop** button in the upper left and exit the presentation
- 7. Review your recording by clicking the **From Beginning** button at the front of the ribbon
- 8. If you are satisfied with your recording, click on the **File** tab and select **Save As**
- 9. Select where you would like to save your recording
- 10. Change your file type to MPEG-4 Video (*.mp4), name your file and save
- 11. Review the export of your recorded presentation.

PowerPoint on Mac:

- 1. Click on the **Slide Show** tab
- 2. Click on **Record Slide Show** button the recording will start **immediately**
- 3. Begin talking through your presentation and be careful when transitioning between slides
- 4. Once finished exit the presentation and accept or decline if you would like to *save the new slide timing*, when prompted.
- 5. Review your recording by clicking the **From Beginning** button at the front of the ribbon
- 6. If you are satisfied with your recording, click on the **File** and select **Export**
- 7. Select where you would like to save your recording
- 8. Change your *file type* to **MP4** and set *quality* to **Presentation Quality**, name your file and save
- 9. Review the export of your recorded presentation.

Keynote:

- 1. Click on the **Play** menu
- 2. Click on Record Slideshow
- 3. When ready to record, click the red **Record** button in the lower left
- 4. Begin talking through your presentation and be careful when transitioning between slides
- 5. Once finished, click the red **Record** button in the lower left and exit the presentation
- 6. Review your recording by clicking the Play menu and selecting Play Recorded Slideshow
- 7. If you are satisfied with your recording, click on the **File** and select **Export To > Movie**
- 8. Double check that Movie is selected in Export Your Presentation
- 9. Set *Playback* to **Sideshow Recording**
- 10. Set *Resolution* to **1080p**
- 11. Press Next
- 12. Select where you would like to save your recording, name your file and save
- 13. Review the export of your recorded presentation
